

## Presidents Cups Rules – SATURDAY MATCH PLAY

**Format:** **Front 9:** Two-man team Better Ball. Strokes are indicated on the card are calculated off the lowest indexed player in the foursome. Teams receive two points for winning the hole, one point for a tie and zero points for losing the hole. Highest total points on the front 9 wins.

**Back 9:** 2-man Scramble. **Total Team Score (not per hole match play)** Handicaps are 35% of low player's index plus 15% of high player's index from the Gold tees. Both players tee off, select the better ball location, then both players hit the second shot. Continue this format until the hole is complete. Off the green, the ball must be placed no more than one club length from the original shot, no closer to the hole and in the same cut of grass or sand. On the green, both players putt from the original marked location of the ball. **Record your score for each hole. Any strokes will be deducted from your total score after the round.**

**Tees:** All players play from the **Gold Tees**.

**Sand Traps:** **Front 9:** Play your ball where it lands UNLESS it lands in a footprint or poorly raked location. You may rake and place your ball back to where it was if this is the case.

**Back 9:** Lift clean and place. Must remain in the sand, one club length, no closer to the hole

**Scoring:** Each 9 nine holes is considered a separate match. The winning team from each match receives 1 point, ties are ½ point per team. Individual scores will not be posted on the CDGA site.

## Presidents Cups Rules -- SUNDAY

**Format:** Individual Match Play for all 18 holes. USGA and Wilmette Golf Course rules are to be followed. As individual matches, teammates may NOT give advice or assistance to one another with regards to club selection or reading putts. Giving distances is allowed. All putts must be holed out unless the hole or stroke is conceded. Strokes will be indicated on the cards.

**Tees:** All players play from the **Gold Tees**.

**Sand Traps:** Play your ball where it lands UNLESS it lands in a footprint or poorly raked location. You may rake and place your ball back to where it was if this is the case.

**Scoring:** The winner of the 18-hole match earns 1 point. Ties receive ½ point per man.
